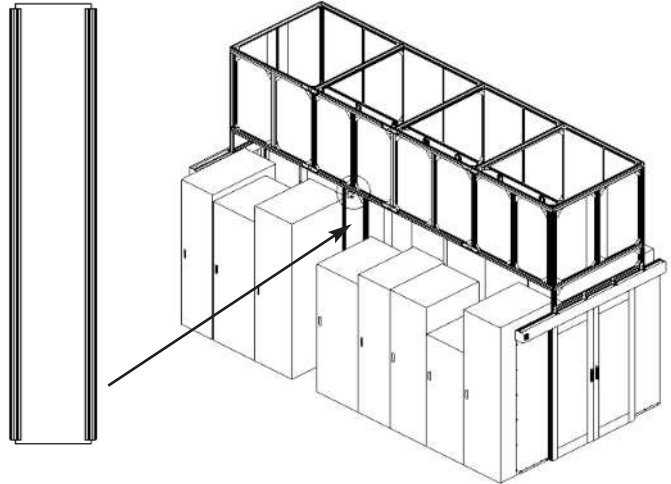
## AISLE CONTAINMENT FULL HEIGHT CABINET BLANKING PANEL FOR BUILD TO SPEC KIT

The Full Height Cabinet Blanking Panel is an optional accessory that is used in combination with the Build To Spec Kit to fill gaps between cabinets when a cabinet is omitted from the aisle/cabinet row.

- Use with the Build To Spec Kit (See 33000\_CUT) to fill gaps when a cabinet is omitted from the aisle/cabinet row
- Includes extrusions, brackets, panels and edge seals required to field fabricate a full height blanking panel
- Allows you to add, remove or omit cabinets as required
- Fits snug against the sides of the adjacent cabinets
- Field fabricated to match site requirements
- Assemble and install with common tools
- 96" (2438 mm) high x 48" (1219 mm) wide translucent panel can be cut to fit the opening and allows light to enter the contained aisle
- Aluminum extrusion and steel brackets are painted glacier white or black to match cabinets
